Dakshin Gujarat Vij Company Limited (DGVCL) has filed petition for Annual Performance Review 2009-10 and Approval to continue existing tariff for FY 2010-11 on 23rd December-2009. The Petition has been registered as case no. 993 of 2010.

In this regard, DGVCL most respectfully submits herewith a corrigendum to the above petition as under:

1. At sr. no. 10 of PART-I of SCHEDULE OF TARIFF FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY AT LOW AND MEDIUM VOLTAGE, provisions at sr. no. 10.1 regarding delayed payment charges may be replaced by following.

10.1 No Delayed Payment Charges if the bill is paid within ten days from the date of billing (excluding the date of billing).

Delayed payment charges shall be levied at the rate of 18% per Annum from the date of billing (up to the time of permanent disconnection of supply) in case of all categories of consumers except Agricultural category and at the rate of 12% per Annum for Agricultural category consumers. From the date of permanent disconnection, delayed payment charges shall be levied at the rate of 15% per Annum in case of all categories of consumers except Agricultural category and at the rate of 12% per Annum for Agricultural category consumers.

For Government dues, the delayed payment charged will be levied at the rate provided under the relevant the Electricity Duty Act.

2. At Sr. no. 11.15 of PART-II TARIFFS FOR SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY AT HIGH TENSION (3.3 KV AND ABOVE, 3-PHASE 50 c/s), AND EXTRA HIGH



TENSION, provisions at sr. no. 11.15 regarding delayed payment charges may be replaced by following.

11.15 No Delayed Payment Charges if the bill is paid within ten days from the date of billing (excluding the date of billing).

Delayed payment charges shall be levied at the rate of 18% per Annum from the date of billing (up to the time of permanent disconnection of supply) in case of all categories of consumers except Agricultural category and at the rate of 12% per Annum for Agricultural category consumers. From the date of permanent disconnection, delayed payment charges shall be levied at the rate of 15% per Annum in case of all categories of consumers except Agricultural category and at the rate of 12% per Annum for Agricultural category consumers.

For Government dues, the delayed payment charged will be levied at the rate provided under the relevant the Electricity Duty Act.

Hon'ble Commission is requested to consider the above revision at respective clause of Tariff Schedule of the above petition for proper applicability of the clause.

The company respectfully prays to the Hon'ble Commission to consider the above corrigendum to the petition filed by the company as a part of main petition.
